

RSSoM Presents the YOP Digital Solo Competition

Students in RSYO, YCO and Camerata Strings are invited to participate in our first-ever digital solo competition in Spring 2021! Winners will be selected from Camerata, YCO and RSYO and their videos featured on the RSSoM YouTube channel. The grand prize performance will be featured during the intermission of the Richmond Symphony's Masterworks livestream in April!

Repertoire

Repertoire must be performed unaccompanied, and music may not exceed eight minutes in length. Works written for solo instruments are encouraged, but not required. Your piece should be at the appropriate level and chosen with the help of your private teacher or school music teacher. When choosing repertoire, keep in mind that the winning videos will be presented unaccompanied.

Video Submission

Your performance must be recorded in landscape, unedited, and in one single take. Students must submit the final video between March 1 and March 31. No videos will be accepted after March 31, 2021.

In consideration of the potential performance during a Richmond Symphony livestream event, mindfulness is appreciated with both your presentation in dress and surroundings in your recording. Please note that if your video exceeds eight minutes in length, but the musical content is within the eight-minute parameter, we may make cuts to pauses between movements or portions of the video that do not contain musical content as appropriate.
